- 10. Board discussed HWY 66 JP#31092(04) project in Rogers County. ODOT contractor hit the RWD 5 line on HWY 66. RWD 5 was not notified this project was occurring. Kyle Sewell with Bartlett & West has contacted ODOT and requested the project plans. Once plans have been reviewed it will be determined how RWD 5 moves forward with relocating the line.
